United Way and Mid Island Co-op Team Up for Change for Change!

Nanaimo, BC – May 20, 2014 – In May and June, change from the coin boxes at Mid Island Co-op’s Gas Stations are giving a boost to United Way’s efforts to help vulnerable children, youth, adults and seniors in our community. The money from coin boxes placed at Mid Island Co-op’s Ladysmith, Nanaimo, Gabriola, Parksville, Whiskey Creek, Chemainus and Salt Spring Island locations will be donated to United Way Central and Northern Vancouver Island to be invested back into effective programs in our community. To top it off, Mid Island Co-op is donating an additional \$500 to United Way.

Susan Urban, Marketing and Community Relations Manager of Mid Island Co-op, confirms that their members “want to support many organizations that build long-term change and capacity in our community. We chose United Way because it has a long history of effective community building in the Central Island.” Today, United Way not only raises money to fund community programs, but also helps to research the underlying causes of social issues to direct resources to programs that address positive change for the long term.

The change from the coin boxes will have a direct impact on 33 programs in the Central Island. For example four of these programs give 1,400 youth access to suicide prevention programs, serve lunch to 135 people every week, prepare 800 meals during cooking sessions for low income families, and allow 16 youth with disabilities to go to summer camp.

“We’re grateful to Mid Island Co-op and to all their customers and members,” said Laura Heikkila, Campaign & Community Impact Associate at United Way. “Believe me, every penny is important to our Community Partners who work so hard to create and deliver powerful programs that serve the most vulnerable in our community.”
