Nanaimo, BC – May 20, 2014 – In May and June, change from the coin boxes at Mid Island Co-op’s Gas Stations are giving a boost to United Way’s efforts to help vulnerable children, youth, adults and seniors in our community. The money from coin boxes placed at Mid Island Co-op’s Ladysmith, Nanaimo, Gabriola, Parksville, Whiskey Creek, Chemainus and Salt Spring Island locations will be donated to United Way Central and Northern Vancouver Island to be invested back into effective programs in our community. To top it off, Mid Island Co-op is donating an additional \$500 to United Way.

Susan Urban, Marketing and Community Relations Manager of Mid Island Co-op, confirms that their members “want to support many organizations that build long-term change and capacity in our community. We chose United Way because it has a long history of effective community building in the Central Island.” Today, United Way not only raises money to fund community programs, but also helps to research the underlying causes of social issues to direct resources to programs that address positive change for the long term.

The change from the coin boxes will have a direct impact on three programs in Parksville and Qualicum Beach. In one program, adults with developmental disabilities learn important skills to help them to live as independently as possible. Another program helps 86 adults to recover from the death of loved one and to look forward to the future. A third program improves the health and wellbeing of 80 children, youth and adults with physical and mental disabilities when they learn to ride a horse and to interact with horses and people.

“We’re grateful to Mid Island Co-op and to all their customers and members,” said Laura Heikkila, Campaign & Community Impact Associate at United Way. “Believe me, every penny is important to our Community Partners who work so hard to create and deliver powerful programs that serve the most vulnerable in our community.”
